#### Most common exposures, adults 20-59 years:

- 1. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 2. Sedatives and antipsychotics
- 3. Antidepressants
- 4. Alcohols
- 5. Stimulants and street drugs

#### Most common exposures, adults 60 years and older:

- 1. Heart medicines
- 2. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 3. Sedatives and antipsychotics
- 4. Cosmetics and personal care products
- 5. *(tie)* Hormones (including antidiabetic and thyroid medicines) Household cleaning products
