- 3. Foreign bodies
- 4. Pesticides
- 5. (*tie*) Analgesics (pain relievers) Antimicrobials Cold and cough medicines
- (tie) Arts and crafts products Plants Topical medicines (for the skin)

Most common exposures, children 6-19 years:

- 1. (*tie*) Antidepressants Sleep medicines and antipsychotics Cold and cough medicines
- (tie) Antihistamines
 Cold and cough medicines
 Foreign bodies
 Other/unknown non-drug substances

Most common exposures, adults 20 years and older:

- 1. Sleep medicines and antipsychotics
- 2. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 3. Anticonvulsants
- 4. Antidepressants
- 5. (*tie*) Alcohols Other/unknown non-drug substances Pesticides
- 8. Chemicals
- 9. (*tie*) Antimicrobials Heart medicines Household cleaning products

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
