Most common exposures, children 6-19 years:

- 1. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 2. Cold and cough medicines
- 3. Sleep medicines and antipsychotics
- 4. Stimulants and street drugs
- 5. Antidepressants
- 6. *(tie)* Antihistamines Foreign bodies Vitamins
- 9. (*tie*) Alcohols Anticonvulsants Cosmetics and personal care products Household cleaning products

Most common exposures, adults 20 years and older:

- 1. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 2. Sleep medicines and antipsychotics
- 3. Antidepressants
- 4. Heart medicines
- 5. Hormones
- 6. Bites and stings
- 7. (tie) Antihistamines

Household cleaning products

- 8. Anticonvulsants
- 9. Pesticides
- 10.(tie) Antimicrobials
