- 1. Cosmetics and personal care products
- 2. Household cleaning products
- 3. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 4. Topical medicines (for the skin)
- 5. Foreign bodies
- 6. Cold and cough medicines
- 7. Gastrointestinal medicines (for the stomach)
- 8. Heart medicines
- 9. Electrolytes and minerals
- 10. Antihistamines

Most common exposures, children 6-19 years:

- 1. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 2. Cold and cough medicines
- 3. *(tie)* Antidepressants Sleep medicines and antipsychotics
- (tie) Alcohols Foreign bodies Stimulants and street drugs
- 8. Cosmetics and personal care products
- 9. Vitamins
- 10. Household cleaning products

Most common exposures, adults 20 years and older:

- 1. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 2. Sleep medicines and antipsychotics
- 3. Heart medicines
- 4. Antidepressants
- 5. Household cleaning products
- 6. Pesticides
- 7. Anticonvulsants
- 8. (tie) Alcohols
