# Most common exposures, adults 60 years and older:

- 1. Heart medicines
- 2. (tie) Analgesics (pain relievers)

Hormones (including antidiabetic and thyroid medicines)

3. (tie) Anticholinergic medicines

Foreign bodies

GI medicines (for the stomach)

Sleep medicines and antipsychotics
