#### Most common exposures, children under 6 years:

- 1. Cosmetics and personal care products
- 2. Household cleaning products
- 3. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 4. Topical medicines (for the skin)
- 5. Foreign bodies

#### Most common exposures, children 6-19 years:

- 1. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 2. *(tie)* Household cleaning products Sleep medicines and antipsychotics
- 4. *(tie)* Antihistamines Stimulants and street drugs

#### Most common exposures, adults 20-59 years:

- 1. Sleep medicines and antipsychotics
- 2. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 3. Alcohols
- 4. Antidepressants
- 5. Anticonvulsants

#### Most common exposures, adults 60 years and older:

- 1. Heart medicines
- (tie) Analgesics (pain relievers) Hormones (including antidiabetic and thyroid medicines) Sleep medicines and antipsychotics
- 5. Household cleaning products
