Most common exposures, children under 6 years:

- 1. (tie) Antihistamines
 - Cosmetics and personal care products
- 3. Pesticides
- 4. *(tie)* Household cleaning products Vitamins

Most common exposures, children 6-19 years:

- 1. Antidepressants
- 2. Topical medicines (for the skin)
- 3. Cosmetics and personal care products
- 4. Sedatives and antipsychotics
- 5. Four substances tied with 3 exposures each

Most common exposures, adults 20-59 years:

- 1. Antidepressants *(tie)* Sedatives and antipsychotics
- 3. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 4. Household cleaning products
- 5. Antihistamines

Most common exposures, adults 60 years and older:

- 1. *(tie)* Analgesics (pain relievers) Pesticides Sedatives and antipsychotics
- 4. Several substances with 1 exposure each
