#### Most common exposures, children under 6 years:

- 1. Cosmetics and personal care products
- 2. (tie) Household cleaning products; Pesticides
- 4. Foreign bodies and toys
- 5. Deodorizers

### Most common exposures, children 6-19 years:

- 1. Household cleaning products
- 2. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 3. Several substances tied with one exposure

### Most common exposures, adults 20-59 years:

- 1. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 2. Anticonvulsants
- 3. (tie) Alcohols; Antihistamines; Chemicals, Heart medicines; Household cleaning products; Sedatives and antipsychotics
- 5. Several substances tied with one exposure

### Most common exposures, adults 60 years and older:

- 1. (tie) Chemicals; Veterinary drugs
- 3. Heart medicines
- 4. Several substances tied with one exposure
