#### Most common exposures, adults 20-59 years:

- 1. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 2. Cold and cough medicines
- 3. Household cleaning products
- 4. Sleep medicines and antipsychotics
- 5. *(tie)* Cosmetics and personal care products Food and food poisoning

## Most common exposures, adults 60 years and older:

- 1. Heart medicines
- 2. Household cleaning products
- Diuretics
- 4. (tie) Antimicrobials

GI medicines (for the stomach)

Hormones (including antidiabetic and thyroid medicines)

Sleep medicines and antipsychotics
