Most common exposures, children under 6 years:

- 1. (tie) Cosmetics and personal care products; Plants
- 3. (tie) Analgesics (pain relievers); Dietary supplements; Foreign bodies and toys

Most common exposures, children 6-19 years:

- 1. Foreign bodies and toys
- 2. Cosmetics and personal care products
- 3. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 4. (tie) Antihistamines; Household cleaning products; Vitamins

Most common exposures, adults 20-59 years:

- 1. Stimulants and street drugs
- 2. Analgesics (pain relievers)
- 3. (tie) Alcohols; Heart medicines; Household cleaning products

Most common exposures, adults 60 years and older:

- 1. (tie) Antihistamines; Household cleaning products; Miscellaneous medicines
- 4. Several substances tied with one exposure each
