Do not chew on or open glow sticks.

While non-toxic, the liquid can irritate the eyes, mouth, and throat.

Poisoned candy is a myth. Investigated cases of suspected

poisoned candy reveal some other health concern.



If needed, call the poison experts.

Pharmacists and nurses answer the phone 24/7/365.



**Bloomed chocolate** is safe to eat.

The white coating is caused by temperature changes.



Wear gloves to handle dry ice.

Dry ice can cause burns if handled directly.

Use non-toxic makeup and face paint.



Although non-toxic, they can still irritate the skin and eyes.
